- D.E.D. Daniels provides a summary of the resolutions, RES# 2023-58 authorizes the payment of monthly expenses, RES# 2023-59 is a roll call vote regarding the approval of GHA's FY2024 budget, RES# 2023-60 is a resolution designating officials to enroll in GOVCONNECT, which is a government run website that will allow the designated officials to receive notices from the Department of local government services on finance or legal notices issued, RES# 2023-61 awards the contract for sealcoating and crack repair at GHA's three properties, RES# 2023-62 approves sidewalk tripping repair to eliminate any hazards at Sumit Park and RES# 2023-63 approves an executive session to discuss matters that fall under the open public contracts law.
