#### **AFINANCIAL REPORT:**

- Accountant Michael Jezierski reviewed the Financial Report shared with the June Packets. The
  Statement of Revenue and Expenses show GHA is operating at a positive, once depreciation is
  added back. Commissioner Shirley Anderson inquiries about GHA's collection of back rent due
  to COVID. E.D. Gober indicates that GHA is pursuing eviction for outstanding rents after
  exhausting all options to assist our residents. Accountant Michael Jezierski indicates that GHA
  sends out monthly letters to any residents in arrears including a reminder of the outstanding
  balances.
- E.D. Gober indicates audits are near completion, the State recently released the GASB68 report, which reports all entities in the pension fund and their respective liabilities, the audits cannot be completed without this information, the audits are anticipated to be completed by the end of July 2024.

# **DIRECTORS REPORT:**

- E.D. Gober indicates that Commissioner Edward Hutchinson has officially submitted his resignation. Resolution 2024-38 asks the Board to recognize the Commissioner's dedicated service as a Board Commissioner to the Housing Authority of the Borough of Glassboro.
- E.D. Gober indicates RES# 2024-39 asks the Board to ratify emergency contracts for the repair to damaged wire leading to utility poles resulting in the need for emergency work repair. During a snowstorm in February 2024, building six at Summit Park had a power outage, maintenance responded and was not able to restore power, an electrician was then contacted as well as Atlantic City Electric, who found an underground electric line that faulted. This emergency did impact heat for the tenants. Total repair expenses relating to this emergency were \$14,471.76.
- E.D. Gober indicates that HUD is implementing a new inspection standard for the Housing Choice Voucher Program. Currently, the inspection protocol is Housing Quality Standards which will eventually change to N.S.P.I.R.E National Standard for Physical Inspection Real Estate. This inspection was to initially take effect on October 1, 2023, GHA accepted a deferral offered by

HUD which deferred implementation until October 1, 2024. Now, HUD has recently informed that they are delaying implementation until October 1, 2025.

- E.D. Gober indicates that HOTMA (Housing Opportunity through Modernization Act), will change the way Housing Authorities calculate income, the implementation of HOTMA has been delayed a few times, at this time HUD has HOTMA taking effect on January 1, 2025. Running parallel with the HOTMA implementation, HUD is converting from PIC to HIP reporting software. This software is what all Public Housing Authorities use to submit data to HUD. HUD recently informed Housing Authorities that both HOTMA and HIP have been delayed again.
- E.D. Gober indicates there is an article by VOX included in the Board Packet regarding a test
  program that would issue housing funds for unit rentals directly to the participants, instead of
  third-party landlords.
