Specific authorization to expend funds for the purposes described in this section of the budget must be granted elsewhere; by bond resolution, by a project financing agreement, by resolution appropriating funds from the Renewal and Replacement Reserve or other means provided by law.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the governing body of the Glassboro Housing Authority, at an open public meeting held on October 15, 2024 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, and the Capital Budget/Program of the Housing Authority of the Borough of Glassboro for the fiscal year beginning January 01, 2025 and ending December 31, 2025, is hereby approved; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the said Housing Authority's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and
